Old Stone Cider: Reviving the Tradition

A free talk by Mary Ann Gruber

Please join us for a brief history of cider production as well as a discussion about the vintage apple varieties used by Old Stone Cider, which opened in late 2016 in a reconstructed barn in Lewisville, PA.

Mary Ann Gruber moved to Elk Township in 1992 with a husband and three small children, and the desire to expand the family Christmas tree business. Their 32-acre Old Stone Farm has expanded over the years to 75 acres, and now is home to Old Stone Cider. Mary Ann serves on the Elk Planning Commission and the Elk History Commission, and is a supporter of farm land preservation.
