Eastern Shore Natural Gas Company (ESNG) is a natural gas transmission company headquartered in Dover, Delaware. ESNG is a fully owned subsidiary of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation, which is a diversified utility company engaged in natural gas distribution, transmission and other related businesses on the Delmarva Peninsula.

ESNG is currently in the process of preparing a filing in order to upgrade their natural gas pipeline through portions of Chester County, PA. The upgrade will include installing approximately 3.5 miles of 16-inch pipeline. The project originates at the intersection of Hess Mill Road and Wingate Drive, travels east and south around Kemblesville, PA and will terminate along Walker Road, west of Appleton Road. The proposed route will be a combination of utilizing the existing right of way and in some areas ESNG will need to purchase permanent easements for facilities or temporary workspaces for construction activities. At the present time we do not know if a permanent easement or a temporary workspace is needed on your land. If a permanent easement or temporary workspace is needed we will contact you.

In the meantime ESNG's employees and consulting agents may need access to your land to perform pre-engineering work. The pre-engineering work will primarily involve people walking on your land and may include some minor hand digging to locate property line markers or archaeological features that might be present on your property. At no time will there be a need for anyone to enter your residence or any other buildings on your land.

Examples of pre-engineering work include: surveyors searching for property line markers, measuring and locating physical features, and marking certain locations with flags, paint or stakes; architectural historians who may take a photograph of your property for informational purposes; and archeologists who will hand dig small holes to view the subsurface for potential artifacts. Any

stakes or flags will be placed so as to cause the least disturbance to your land and holes will be immediately re-filled.

Please be assured that ESNG stands behind the work to be performed by its employees and agents. If you require any special conditions before anyone goes on your land, contact Charles D.
