**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THREE
ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Section 203(e) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (MPC) permits the Board of Supervisors to appoint up to three residents of a municipality to serve as alternate members of the planning commission.

WHEREAS, the members of the Franklin Township Planning Commission (the "Planning Commission") must occasionally miss or recuse themselves from proceedings of the Planning Commission, preventing the Planning Commission from reaching a quorum.

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors desires to appoint three residents of Franklin Township as alternate members of the Planning Commission, to substitute for any member of the Planning Commission who is absent or has recused himself or herself from a proceeding.

WHEREAS, Alternates shall serve a term of office for four years except for the initial term which shall be staggered as outlined below.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Franklin that;


1. Penelope Schenk, a current resident of Franklin Township, is appointed as an alternate member of the Franklin Township Planning Commission to a four-year term of office.
2. Zach Elwyn, a current resident of Franklin Township, is appointed as an alternate member of the Franklin Township Planning Commission to a three-year term of office.
3. Paul Lagasse, a current resident of Franklin Township, is appointed as an alternate member of the Franklin Township Planning Commission to a two-term of office.
4. For purposes of designating alternates on a case-by-case rotating basis according to declining seniority, pursuant to Section 207(b) of the MPC, Penelope Schenk shall be considered be the most senior alternate, Zach Elwyn shall be

considered the next most senior alternate and Paul Lagasse shall be considered the least senior alternate.

5. Penelope Schenk, Zach Elwyn, and Paul Lagasse shall serve on the Planning Commission and participate in proceedings and discussions of the Planning Commissioner to the extent permitted by the MPC. All service and participation by Penelope Schenk, Zach Elwyn and Paul Lagasse as alternate members of the Planning Commission shall be conducted in accordance with the MPC.


